Consent Sheet

Protecting your child's data & images

The General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) and the Data Protection Act cover the security and handling of personal data, some of which are classed as 'Sensitive Personal Data', and include electronically stored, as well as paper-based information. To hold this 'Personal Data', and other details within our records, we need your explicit consent, which you are free to withdraw at any time. This information helps the Group to provide Scouting safely and appropriately, and typically includes the following information about your child:

- name & date of birth to allow us to record their progress in Scouting
- contact information so that we can get hold of you, should we need to do so •
- health & well-being so that we are prepared for medical emergencies •
- disabilities to make sure that your child's participation in activities is safe
- religious or similar beliefs to help us to make appropriate arrangements, when necessary
- racial or ethnic origin so that we are sensitive to their cultural needs
- presence at meetings for badgework, and to enable 'contact tracing', should the need arise

The Group uses the internet-based 'Online Scout Manager' to hold these records, which is GDPR compliant and will keep them for seven years after your child leaves the Group. The Group does not disclose the information it holds to third parties outside the Scout Movement, without your consent. You can check the information that the Group has to ensure that it is accurate and up-to-date, by using the 'My.SCOUT' facility.

Sometimes photographs, digital and video images of your child taking part in activities are used within the Group, in District or County Newsletters, on Facebook and websites, are submitted to local newspapers, or are put on display. However, when this happens, the individual's name is not linked to the picture. To store and use these types of images of your child, both while they are a member, and after that for historical purposes, we need your consent.

Subscriptions & Gift Aid Donation

The Group uses the 'Online Scout Manager' to hold financial data. This information includes your child's monthly subscription and other one-off costs for special activities such as sleep-overs, camps or visits, also whether each individual is eligible for Gift Aid.

If you pay Income Tax, please participate in the Group's Gift Aid Scheme. This scheme allows the Group to reclaim tax on any qualifying donation and subscription made in the past four years, as well as all future gifts of money that you make; regardless of whether it is regular payment or a one-off. It is not a legal document and does not ask you to commit to paying the membership subscription for a set period. Please notifying the Group if you: giftaid it

- Want to cancel this declaration
- Change your name or home address
- No longer pay sufficient tax on your income or capital gains

Keeping in touch

Occasionally, e-mail communications and newsletters are issued, to keep you informed of developments and events taking place in the Beavers, Cubs, Scouts or the Group as a whole. The Group also needs your consent to issue these to you.
